

Decision Making Process (the numbers in the drawing above match the numbers on the left below):

- (1) God gives us rules to follow (the rule carries the temptation). Gen 2:17a
- (2) God gives us free will to obey or disobey the rules. Gen 2:17b
- (3) Satan uses Doubt, Denial, and Deception (D3) to get us to disobey. Gen 3:1-5
- (4) Satan will attack when we are <u>Hungry</u>, <u>Angry</u>, <u>Lonely</u>, or <u>Tired</u> (<u>HALT</u>). 1 Pet 5:8
- (5) For help, Christians have the Holy Spirit living inside (1 Jn 4:4), and
- (6) The Armor of God's Word standing between us and Satan. Eph 6:11-18
- (7) Need more help? Cry out, "Satan, the <u>LORD</u> rebuke you!" Jude 9; Zech 3:2
- (8) But beware, if we continue to choose to fill our heart with things other than God,
- (9) We will suffer the consequences, yes (Gen 2:17b); but
- (10) God sacrificed His Son Jesus Christ so that believers can be forgiven. 1 Jn 1:9
